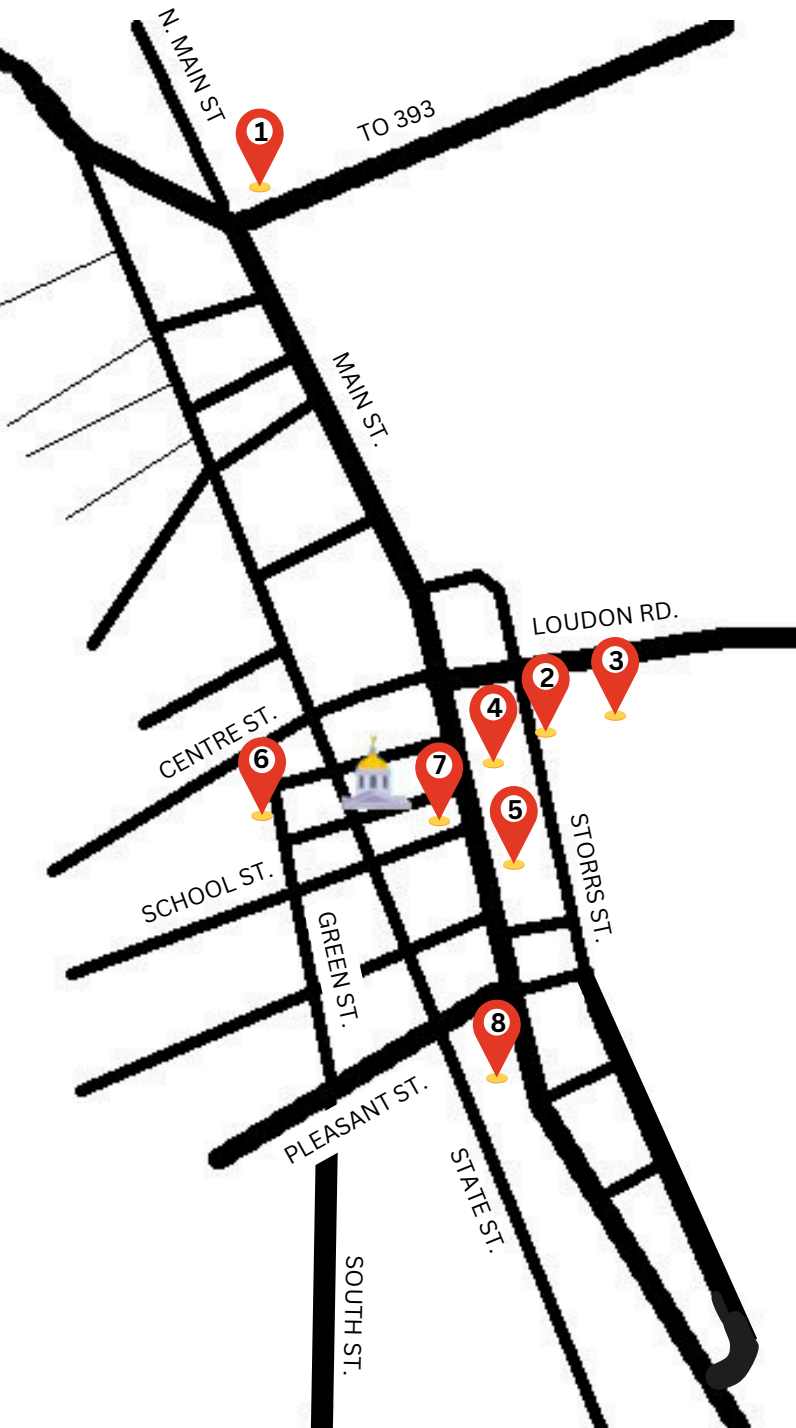


CONCORD'S MURAL WALK MAP

Kimball Jenkins School of Art (Behind the Yellow House) "Colors of Change"

This outdoor painting was designed and painted by NH youth as part of the Haley Rae Martin Memorial Project.



Storrs St. (Stairwell to Eagle Square) "Love Mural"

Muralist James Chase painted this vibrant display of abstract shapes and colors in 2022.



Ralph Pill Building (34 Bridge St.)

This large-scale vinyl-printed mural was designed and produced by Kimball Jenkins art students as part of the Haley Rae Martin Memorial Project.



Eagle Square (Tandy's Restaurant, 1 Eagle Square) "Support Child Care!"

Advocacy group, New Futures, created this tribute to childcare using art made by kids in NH daycare centers in 2023.



Main Street CVS Building (46 N. Main St.)

This painted mural was designed and produced by Kimball Jenkins art students as part of the Haley Rae Martin Memorial Project.



Concord Public Library (Indoor, 45 Green St.)

Artist Lizz Van Saun designed glass mosaics as a collaborative piece in celebration of Concord's 250th birthday. Lizz worked with citizens to place each tile to make true community art!



Cobblestone (Corner of Main St. & School St.)

Building owner Steve Duprey wanted vibrant color to brighten up the traditional red brick construction. A NH-based photographer's flowers did the job!



5 S. State St (Access behind Bean & Bakery, 15 Pleasant St.) "Donkey Kong Mural"
